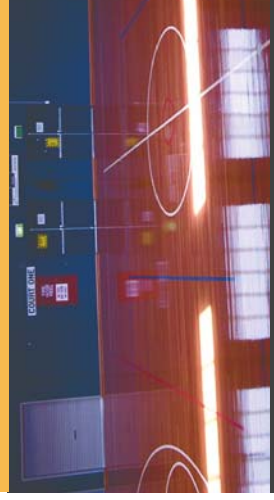

Site Requirements

Hazardous Substances



Class 3 FLAMMABLE LIQUIDS (Solvents)
Are liquids that give off flammable vapour which can ignite by spark or naked flame.



Class 5.1 OXIDIZING SUBSTANCES
While themselves not necessarily combustible, they react to promote combustion of other materials.



Class 8 CORROSIVE LIQUIDS OR SOLIDS
Are products that will cause burns in contact with skin and eyes or by inhalation and ingestion. Treat affected areas immediately with copious amounts of water. Will corrode metals and many other substances. Can be an acid or alkaline material.



Class 6 TOXIC SUBSTANCES
May cause death or serious injury or harm to human health if swallowed or inhaled or by skin contact.

Forklift Safety

- ① Safety vests or high visibility clothing must be worn in all forklift work areas.
- ① Pedestrians must walk inside the marked walkways in forklift work areas.
- ① Always use safety cages to lift people. Do not climb storage racking.
- ① Do not walk behind forklifts or under forklift tyres.



Warning Signs

Observe all warning signs as they are considered to be work instructions.
